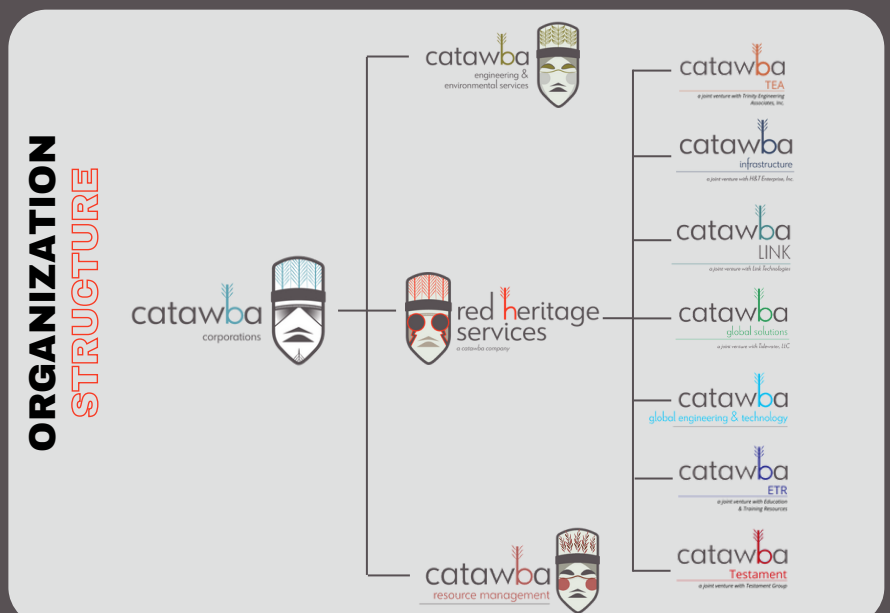

Founded in 2016, RHS is headquartered in Rock Hill, SC with a satellite office in Oak Ridge, TN. In 2017, the corporate charter was updated to concentrate on five core focus areas: Facilities Maintenance and Operation, Professional Services, Information Management, Construction Services, and Security Services. RHS has provided these focus areas to the Catawba Nations since 1996 for over 3,500 tribal members that reside on over 1,500 acres of land in the State of South Carolina. Evidence of our ability to manage large contracts is the delivery of a diverse set of services through the day-to-day operation of a government entity. RHS holds a facility clearance from the NRC and DoD at the Top-Secret level and has received a favorable FOCI determination.

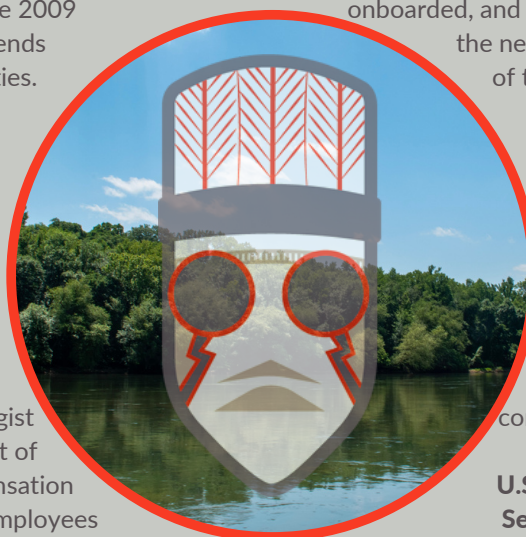
